Multi-Domain Operations at Strategic through Tactical Echelons

- Survivable, secure, end-to-end network
- Enables leaders to compete, fight and win in large-scale combat operations
- Joint/ Coalition, Allies and Partners
- Resilient, defensible, maneuverable

2. Posture Force for Multi-Domain Operations (MDO)

Global SIPR Modernization (PEO EIS Lead: PM IEN)

- Supports LOE Task - “Set the Unified Network”
- Enablers: Commercial Solution(s) for Classified, Virtual Desktop Infrastructure (VDI), Multiple Independent Levels of Security (MILS)

Voice Modernization (PEO EIS Lead: PM IEN)

- Supports LOE Task - “Set the Unified Network”
- Intent: Attempt to reduce overall phone count, regionalize existing VOIP capabilities, implement a regional modernization approach, decommission Time Division Multiplexing (TDM) infrastructure
