WHO WE ARE

Enterprise Business Systems – Convergence (EBS-C) is a project office within PEO Enterprise that supports Army business system modernization and is focused on market research and prototyping. EBS-C is supported by the Army's Enterprise Business System Multi-Functional Capabilities Team (EBS-MFCT), a coalition of functional representatives driving requirements for enterprise resource planning readiness and modernization by 2032.

WHAT IS EBS-C?

EBS-C will provide sweeping improvements to Army business processes across the enterprise. Specifically, it will:

- Re-engineer business processes against commercial best practices to reduce customization and related costs
- Streamline the logistics supply chain across numerous classes of supply
- Serve as the Army's authoritative source for financials and auditability
- Provide a solution that can adapt to changing conditions at the speed of conflict

WHAT DOES THE PROJECT OFFICE DO?

The EBS-C project office is charged with the creation of the acquisition strategy, as well as development and deployment of the Army's modernized/converged ERP system.
